2024 EMMAUS GIFT SUGGESTIONS

- New unwrapped gifts. No clothes, except for infants.
- All gift cards should be delivered to Rev. Kenya Thompson or Mrs. Beverly Banks-Greene at the Emmaus House Main Office, 1017 Hank Aaron.
- Do not donate military toys, especially guns!
- We run out of gifts for ages 9-18.
- If gifts require batteries, please provide them.

Infants: Diapers, wipes, bottles, pacifiers, blankets, sleepers, baby lotion, powder, shampoo, drinking cups and educational toys. Clothing for 1-year olds and younger.

Toddlers, 1-2 years:

Girls: culturally sensitive dolls, tea sets, and kitchen sets.

Boys: age-appropriate cars and trucks.

Unisex: musical and educational toys, games, backpacks, art sets, building blocks, balls, crayons, and coloring books.

3 - 5 years:

Girls: culturally sensitive dolls, jewelry, purses, barrettes and hair accessories, dish/tea sets, jump ropes.

Boys: trucks, cars, and action figures.

Unisex: sports equipment, scooters, helmets, backpacks, sleeping bags, stuffed animals, art and craft sets, magic sets, sidewalk chalk, and educational toys.

6 - 8 years

Girls: culturally sensitive dolls, jewelry, purses, hair accessories, dish/tea sets and jump ropes.

Boys: trucks, car collections, and action figures.

Unisex: Sports equipment, scooters, helmets, backpacks, sleeping bags, art and craft and magic sets, science sets, educational toys, and board games.

<u>9 - 12 years</u>

Girls: jewelry making kits, jewelry sets, small fashion back packs and purses, perfume, arts and crafts supplies, socks and slippers, games.

Boys: sports equipment, socks, and watches. Compact blue tooth speakers, belts, backpacks, footballs, basketballs, hat/scarf/glove sets.

Unisex: back packs, sleeping bags, board games, science sets, compact blue tooth speakers, ear buds and phone chargers, uno cards, board games. Sports team paraphernalia (cups, tumblers, blankets)- UGA, GSU, GATECH, Falcons, Hawks, Atlanta Dream, Atlanta United. Lava lamps. LED lights.

13 - 18 years

Girls: makeup kits, flat irons, purses, slippers, perfumes, and lotions, press on nail kits and polish, jewelry sets, hat/scarf/glove sets, jewelry boxes. Bath products.

Boys: sporting equipment, wallets, duffel bags, watches, men's body wash and cologne, shaving items and grooming sets. Compact blue tooth speakers, belts, backpacks, footballs, basketballs, hat/scarf/glove sets.

Unisex: Socks, hats, scarves, gloves, backpacks, blue tooth phone speakers, ear buds, sunglasses, watches and jewelry, blankets, journals. Sports team paraphernalia (cups, tumblers, blankets, flags etc)- Falcons, Hawks, Atlanta Dream, Atlanta United. Uno cards, Jenga. Lava lamps, LED lights.

Gift Cards: Gift cards are always welcomed. We use the gift cards for the older children when we run out of gifts – which happens every year. **Popular gift cards**: McDonald's, Chik A Fila, Walmart, Subway, Target
